

REWIRES: A Sweet Niche (Surface Press)

A Sweet Niche is the work of Keir Cooper & Olly Sellwood.

Sitting between jazz, alternative and rock, they share a musical vocabulary sharpened over two decades. The latest album REWIRES is arranged and performed as a live big band video album.

The bigband includes Ellie Westbrook, Sam Calcott, Josh Perl, Nicky Baigent, Monique Buchanan, Oz Browne, Ben Handysides, Rose Biggin, Luke Toms & Stanley Macdonald - combining members of The Display Team, Knifeworld, North Sea Radio Orchestra, Lost Crowns & Hot Head Show. Keir & Olly have developed a joint vocabulary, which at its core is interested in rhythmic interplay, types of musical cooperation; punctuation and space; and with the bigband, additional interests are of live performance spectacle and a high fidelity full sound.

BIOS

Keir works with guitar + electronics and live art and has been showcased internationally by the British Council for Drama & Dance. He is currently an associate artist with New British Music Theatre.

Original live works include collaborations with Miss Pole Dance UK finalist and theatre academic Rose Biggin, veteran flamenco duo Lola Rueda and Juan Carlos Otero and trans activist and performer Emma Frankland.

As a guitarist, he performs internationally with London-based band Yossarian and guest-spots with TMWKFBIMGYL, a guitar sextet lead by Chris Brett Bailey. His original compositions for theatre & dance have shown acrosss UK, Europe, Canada, Brazil & Indonesia.

Oliver is a composer and saxophonist. As a composer his work has been performed in the UK, US and Europe. He has worked with Zwerm Electric Guitar Quartet, Line Upon Line and the cellist Olly Coates. He is currently studying for a PhD in Music Composition at the University of Southampton with Matthew Shlomowitz, Drew Crawford and Michael Finnissy.

As a saxophonist he also plays in the psychedelic rock band Knifeworld, whose album Bottled Out of Eden (Inside Out Records, 2016) was rated 5* in the Guardian. Additionally he has featured on recordings including: Vôdûn – Ascend (New Heavy Sounds); Necro Deathmort – Overland (Profound Lore Records); Charlie Cawood – The Divine Abstract (Bad Elephant Music); and Emmett Elvin – Bloody Marvels (Bad Elephant Music).

A SWEET NICHE HISTORY

Keir and Oliver have been making music together since childhood. EYE MUSIC was their first output writing for Baritone Sax, Guitar and Drums - recorded at the Eden Project, Cornwall. For EYE MUSIC II, Keir and Oliver spent ten days writing together in Madrid and finished the process with drummer Ben Handysides. Tim Doyle joined on drums for WIRES, which saw the use of occasional electronics across the instruments, and later the mateiral was rearranged for a new Bigband and recorded as a Live Video Album.
